Dear Parish Members.

A review of the church's financial records was performed on January 18, 2025.

We reviewed all bank statements, collection records, deposit receipts, checkbook, expense invoices and reimbursement. We also looked over the Profit and Loss, 2024 Budget and compared the 2023 and 2024 Balance Sheets.

Everything was well organized and seemed to be in good order. Overall, there were only a few issues to make note of:

- 1. The duplicate checks have a security bar that covers the signatures making them difficult to verify: Also, for some of the checks the ink on the copy was so faded that they were unreadable.
- 2. There were a few missing receipts for expense reimbursements, but they accounted for immaterial expenses (less than \$100).
- 3. All expense reimbursement slips had signatures, but a few did not have the required number of signatures (two signatures or three if reimbursing Fr. John).
- 4. Most issues were found on the collection sheets/envelopes. Several collections envelopes were blank and several of the collection sheets themselves had either one or no signatures. Minor counting errors, none of which added up to more than \$20.

We made Fr. John aware of these issues. Overall, we found the church's finances to be in good order and well tracked. The mistakes we found were minor in nature and no cause for concern.
